Overview

Background

- The FEEDBACK Trial aims to reduce road crashes among young drivers by trialling a new intervention that uses technology to analyse driving and provide feedback.
- Telematics technology generates real-time driving and emissions-related data, such as speed, acceleration and braking information, providing drivers with direct feedback on safe and sustainable driving performance.
- University of Melbourne are leading the trial, in collaboration with the University of Western Australia, the University of Melbourne, Monash University, and the Queensland University of Technology. The Trial is also supported by Government agencies including the NSW Government.
- We are seeking volunteers from across NSW (aged 17-20) to participate in the trial.

Trial eligibility

Who is eligible?

- Young people aged 17 20 years old
- Drivers with a P1 licence (red Ps)
- Live in NSW, VIC, QLD or WA
- Have access to a car they drive regularly
- Have a smartphone with location services



How does the trial work?

- Participants download the DrivePoints app and drive as they normally do. The app provides feedback on their driving, including deduction of "Drive Points" for unsafe driving.
- Some participant groups start with \$120 of virtual cash each week that will reduce if they lose "Drive Points" for unsafe driving. All participants are eligible to win the weekly draw of a \$100 e-gift voucher.
- Participation in the trial is 28 weeks. At the conclusion, participants complete a post-trial survey.
- Information collected is kept secure. It can only be accessed and used by the University of Melbourne for research purposes.

While young drivers make up 14% of all licence holders, they are sadly involved in about 25% of all serious crashes in Australia.

Using the Creative Assets Library (CAL)

If you already have an account, log in at <u>creativeassets.transport.nsw.gov.au</u> and search for a specific CAL reference number.

To create an account:
